Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e), a hearing addressing final approval of the settlement, which will include an assessment of the Class Counsel's requested attorney's fees and expenses, will be held at the United States Courthouse, 601 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19106 in Courtroom Lebruary 24, 2015 before J. Mitchell S. Gollberg.
