**STIPULATION AND ORDER**

Plaintiff Tammy Cook (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant Sunny Days In Home Care LLC (“Defendant”), by and through their undersigned counsel, hereby **STIPULATE** as follows:

1. The following class is certified, pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1710: **All persons who were employed by Defendant Sunny Days Home Care LLC and received straight-time compensation for hours worked over 40 per week since November 13, 2012.**

2. Plaintiff Tammy Cook is appointed Class Representative of the Class defined in paragraph 1 above pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1709(2).

3. The law firms of Winebrake & Santillo, LLC and Conboy Law, LLC shall serve as Class Counsel and, as such, shall represent the interests of the above-captioned Plaintiff and all Class Members throughout all future proceedings pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1709(1).

4. The attached “Notice of Class Action Lawsuit” (“Notice Form”) is approved as to form and content.


5. Within fourteen (14) days, Defendant shall provide to Class Counsel the last known address of all Class Members, as defined in paragraph 1.

6. Within seven (7) days of receipt of the names and addresses pursuant to paragraph 5 above, Class Counsel shall mail the Notice Form to each Class Member by first class mail. If the United States Postal Service returns any Notice Form to Class Counsel with a forwarding address, Class Counsel shall promptly re-mail the Notice Form to the forwarding address. If the United States Postal Service returns any Notice Form to Class Counsel without a forwarding address, Class Counsel shall make all reasonable and good faith efforts to obtain an updated address and promptly re-mail the Notice Form to any updated address.

7. Any Class Member wishing to exclude himself/herself from this class action lawsuit must do so by mailing Class Counsel a letter indicating his/her desire to be excluded, as described in Section 6 of the Notice Form. Such exclusion letters must be postmarked within ~~thirty-five (35)~~ <sup>Ninety (90)</sup> days of the original mailing of the Notice Form pursuant to paragraph 6 above. Class Counsel shall collect and serve any exclusion letters on Defense Counsel, within seven (7) days of receipt. Class Counsel shall promptly file any exclusion letters with the Court.


8. Class Counsel shall bear all printing, mailing, and administrative expenses described herein.


